District Governor John Tanionos officially opens the 80th District Convention of Bay State District 8 at 10:00 am on Saturday, June 9, 2012

Roll call of convention delegates is taken, with the attendees recorded by Brother District Secretary Demetrios G. Vidalis

Seat Late Entry Delegates

A motion is put forward by Brother Alex Geourntas to seat Brother George Panagouloupoulos of Brockton, Lord Byron Chapter 57 as a delegate registering late and is seconded by Brother Peter Katsos. The motion passes unanimously.

The District Governor's Report is presented by Brother District Governor John Tanionos (attached).

Brother Constantine Calliontzis is nominated by Brother George Panagopoulos as Convention Chairman.

Brother Calliontzis accepts the nomination.

There are no other nominations.

All present vote in favor.

Brother Theodore Nikolopoulos is nominated by Brother Steven Michaelides as Convention Vice-Chairman.

Brother Nikolopoulos accepts the nomination.

There are no other nominations.

All present vote in favor.

Brother Demetrios G. Vidalis is nominated by Brother Alex Geourntas as Convention Secretary.

Brother Vidalis accepts the nomination.

There are no other nominations.

All present vote in favor.

Minutes from the 79th District 8 Convention, held on May 12, 2011 in Newport, RI, were presented to the convention delegates prior to the convention via postal and electronic mail.

A motion is put forward by Brother Alex Geourntas to accept the minutes of the 2011 79th District 8 Convention and is seconded by Brother Steven Michaelides.

The motion passes unanimously.

Supreme Governor (region 4) **Nicholas Nikas** speaks to the body.

Brother Supreme Governor Nicholas Nikas addresses the body urging every chapter to support the National level of AHEPA by contributing to the 90th Anniversary Supreme Convention Album. He reviews his visitations to District 8 with the body, and thanks those who invited him to participate in their events and meetings. He follows up on a letter he wrote to all chapter officers in the district, particularly on three key points. First being the promoting of Hellenism by having a grass roots liaison from each chapter. He continues on to congratulate District 8 for being able to add the remaining congressmen of Massachusetts to the Hellenic Caucus. He then discusses membership and challenges each chapter to set a 2012 year end membership goal. He informs the Brothers of the upcoming Supreme Convention in Las Vegas, and the 90th anniversary of AHEPA. He opens the floor to answer any questions.

The District Scholarship Committee Report is presented by Brother Theodore Nikolopoulos (attached).

The District Scholarship, Peter L. Bell Scholarship, and Charitable Fund Reports are presented by Brother George Leasca (attached).

A motion is put forward by Brother Joseph Coutlis to accept the District Scholarship, Peter L. Bell Scholarship, and Charitable Fund Reports and is seconded by Brother George Panagopoulos.

The motion passes unanimously.

The District Athletic Committee Report is presented by Brother George Leasca.

Brother Leasca reports on the successful District Bowling Tournament and Sons of Pericles' Basketball Tournament. The district was also able to enter a basketball team into the Harry Agganis Basketball Tournament.

The District Auxiliary Committee Report is presented by Brother Jason-Demetrios Vergados, President of SOP Hub Chapter 27, and Supreme Governor of the Sons of Pericles.

Brother Vergados updates the body as to the status of the Sons nationally, which have grown to over 40 chapters with more than 700 members worldwide.

The Boston SOP has been very active as they participated in numerous Boston AHEPA chapter events, Albany, NY Sons and Maids Valentine's Day dance, Montreal Sons and Maids St. Patrick's Day event, Harry Agganis Basketball Tournament, Sons' West and East Coast Basketball Tournaments. They have also held two successful outings this year, including a Celtic's game outing, and their 5th annual Red Sox cookout and game. The Boston SOP will also be holding their monthly meeting tonight. Brother Vergados further informs the body that many of the Brothers are very active dual members. The Boston chapter of the sons is also the largest in the Order with 77 members. He tells the body of the Boston Sons' plans to host a New Year's Function, build a webpage within the AHEPA District 8 website (baystateAHEPA.org), continue the annual basketball tournament in October, and also begin an outreach with the GOYA's within District 8 to participate with the AHEPA youth, and in the Hellenic History Tournament.

He also notifies the body of increased interest to start Sons of Pericles chapters from Worcester, Lowell, and Watertown.

The Convention Scholarship Committee Report is presented by Brother Peter Katsos

Brother Katsos reports that the committee makes the following recommendations:

- 1) Enforce the By-Laws by having one DOP member on the Scholarship Committee.
- 2) Move the announcement of available scholarships from November to February, so as to allow the Committee enough time to determine what money will be available.
- 3) Use \$10,900 of principle for this year only to fulfill all the scholarships.

A motion is put forward by Brother Steve Michaelides to accept the Convention Scholarships Committee Report and is seconded by Brother George Panagopoulos.

Discussion Follows.

The motion passes.

The Convention Charitable Committee Report is presented by Brother Alex Geourntas. Brother Geourntas reports that the committee makes the following recommendations: Donate \$535 to the Hellenic American Academy in Lowell, MA.

A motion is put forward by Brother Chris Singas to accept the Convention Charitable Committee Report and is seconded by Brother Frank Fotis. The motion passes unanimously.

The Convention Athletic Committee Report is presented by Brother George Leasca. Brother Leasca reports that the committee makes the following recommendations:

- 1) District 8 sponsors a team for the Sons of Pericles 2013 Eastern regional tournament.
- 2) District 8 raises awareness thru a survey to form, with the purpose to form a team to be sponsored for the AHEPA Softball Tournament.
- 3) District 8 post a survey letter for a regional candlepin tournament, with the Athletic Director writing a letter to gauge participation interest. If 5 or more chapters are interested, plan a spring tournament.
- 4) District 8 finds a host chapter for the District 8 Candlepin Bowling Tournament.

A motion is put forward by Brother Alex Geourntas to accept the Convention Athletic Committee Report and is seconded by Brother Steve Michaelides. Discussion follows. The motion passes unanimously.

2013 District 8 Candlepin Bowling Tournament Host City

A motion is put forward by Brother Peter Katsos that Lynn hosts the 2013 District 8 Candlepin Bowling Tournament, and is seconded by Brother Steve Michaelides. The motion passes unanimously.

The Convention Resolutions Committee Report is presented by Brother Athanasios Vulgaropulos. Brother Vulgaropulos reports that the committee makes the following recommendations:

- 1) AHEPA continues to strengthen its grassroots network
- 2) AHEPA continues efforts to grow the Hellenic Caucus
- 3) AHEPA continues to support resolution HR180
- 4) AHEPA urges our government to pressure Turkey to honor religious freedom and cease violating Greek waters and air space
- 5) AHEPA promotes actions to return Parthenon marbles to Greece
- 6) AHEPA strengthens ties with other Hellenic American organizations
- 7) AHEPA supports the Pontian Greek American committee for recognition of the Greek Pontian Genocide
- 8) AHEPA supports a proclamation to make March "Hellenic History Month"
- 9) AHEPA makes efforts to stop Turkey and FYROM from infiltrating revisionist propaganda into school systems
- 10) AHEPA condemns the 1974 Turkish invasion of Cyprus, the illegal occupation of Northern Cyprus, and Turkey's disregard of United Nations Resolutions.
- 11) AHEPA continues support of positions of FYROM issues
- 12) ~~AHEPA should influence the American Government and congress to pressure European Governments, banks, and other financial institutions to actively seek an equitable solution for the resolution of the economic crisis in Greece and other European Union countries.~~

A motion is put forward by Brother Peter Katsos to accept points 1 – 11 of the Convention Resolutions Committee Report and is seconded by Brother Joseph Coutlis. The motion passes unanimously.

A motion is put forward by Brother Constantine Lagos to accept point 12 of the Convention Resolutions Committee Report and is seconded by Brother Damon Bakas. Discussion follows. The motion fails.

The Convention Public Relations Committee Report is presented by Brother Joseph Coutlis

Brother Coutlis reports that the committee makes the following recommendations:

1. District 8 host a community dinner to present donations (i.e. defibrillator, GPS bracelet, etc.) to a VIP guest's organization
2. District 8 establishes a community award to be presented at a ceremony with a light reception.

A motion is put forward by Brother Alex Geourntas to accept the Convention Public Relations Committee Report and is seconded by Brother John Tanionos.

Discussion follows.

The motion passes by a vote of 11 to 8.

The Convention Auditing Committee Report is presented by Brother Chris Singas

Brother Singas reports to the convention that the income and expenses of the District reconciled.

The Convention Budget Committee Report is presented by Brother District Treasurer John Abate

Brother Abate reports that the committee makes the following recommendation:

Each chapter in District 8 pays \$10 per member to the AHEPA Bay State District 8 Lodge. Membership will be based upon the number of members as reported by AHEPA National Headquarters on December 31st of the previous year. It shall include all Active, Life, and Dual members. The \$10 shall be disbursed as \$4.50 towards District 8 communications expenses, \$4.00 towards the District 8 per capita, and \$1.50 towards the District 8 Scholarship Fund.

A motion is put forward by Brother Alex Geourntas to table the Convention Budget Committee recommendation and is seconded by Brother Theodore Nikolopoulos.

District Governor's Report
