I. District Governor/District Officer Reports

District Governor Report:

Thank all of the member chapters for the hospitality and reception that has been shown to him during his visitations. He has tried to visit every chapter at least once this year. Congratulated Boston and Haverhill for their 100th anniversary galas, Boston in September 2023, Haverhill in April 2024. The DG was heartened to see such strong turnout at these events and commend

their effort to put on these important events because they bring chapter members together. Lynn's 100th is happening in fall of 2024. Brockton's is 2025.

DG shared that the district lodge met seven times in the past year. DG congratulated his fellow district officers for their contributions. His hope going forward is that the Lodge stays together going forward.

Visitations: Watertown, Lynn (attended at Christmas. Very encouraged how the chapter is being resurrected) Lowell (meeting, and golf tournament), and Boston.

Mentioned the district to bowling tournament

Charitable donations: donations given to two nursing homes, one in Canton and one in Worcester.

He looks forward to the progress of Ahepa going forward.

Question: Why is Lowell not participating in the District Convention? For that matter why aren't some of the other chapters not present. Response by DG: Not an easy answer. DG finds chapters get busy with their internal events, doesn't excuse it, but does explain. Covid has also had an impact in participation. District Lodge needs to continue to work to encourage their participation.

Peter Vergados: He spoke about his experience with Lowell and Marlborough in not attending the district Convention. When he was District secretary back in 2019, he queried both Lowell and Marlborough about why they were not participating and the response he received was "they were not interested".

Thanked his fellow district officers. Looking forward to the future. It was an honor to mingle with fellow AHEPANs at the WooSox. The goal is for AHEPA to prosper, to promote Hellenism and grow the membership.

J. District Annual Financial Report - George Leasca

Available upon request. He submitted them to the District Secretary. He explained how the funds are managed. They are managed on a scale of 1 to 5 on risk. 1 being very conservative (CDs), 2-4 would be mixed and 5 would be aggressive growth. For the scholarship funds, they are managed 2-3 on the risk scale. They do not take a lot of risk but some of the funds are invested in stocks and not exclusively in CDs etc.

He shared how much income each of the scholarship funds has earned ytd.

K. Sons of Pericles – Maids of Athena - (Status/future)

Michael Condakes: Boston sons - there has not been much activity the past two years, but they have compiled an updated list of members and possible new members. Coming up on the 100th anniversary of the Sons.

Chapter 24 - Brother Kokkotos - big thanks to the District governor for his hard work. Celebrated 100th anniversary. It was a great success. Have a great group of officers. Successful meetings.

Current members are 63.

Do four major events each year. At christmas, they put together baskets to give out to those in need in the community

Lynn - Costa Speridakos - two new officers. 55 members as of December 2023. Two initiations in 2024. Hosted two coffee hours, a christmas party, and a comedy show at the end of May. 100th anniversary event September 27, 2024.

Brockton - Dino Constantiniou: Continue to build membership. Have a committee for their 100th anniversary. Last November 4 they had their inaugural golf tournament. This year they will be giving 2 \$500 scholarships

Worcester - Charles Kiritsy: 121 members. Added 3 new members in 2022. Current membership is 121 members. Lost 5 members in 2022 and 4 members in 2022. Cherish their memory. Conducted audit in 2021. They are able to give up to 5 scholarships of \$1000/per year.

Sponsor superbowl event each year. Worcester has its own AHEPA facility. They share it with the Church. Had a comedy event this past year. Had a Glendi each year. Standing scholarship fund. Death benefit fund.

Mentioned the WooSOX event Worcester Parish and AHEPA co-sponsored.

Watertown - John Abate: 24 members. AHEPA day on May 24. Watertown won the district history tournament. AHEPA sponsors the team.

Woburn Chapter 176 - Dimitri Vasquez: chapter reactivated a year ago. 27 members. Have had 3 lectures. Had a wine tasting. Support Greek owned businesses. Sponsored a team for the history tournament. Have a good relationship with church. Stressed the importance of having this relationship. Sponsored a bus to bring congregation to Greek independence day parade. Thank everyone for coming to the district convention.

Motion was made to approve all reports. Reports were accepted.

COMMITTEE (Standing) REPORTS

1. Scholarship Report : Ask John Abate for summary of scholarships given 15 recipients for 26k of various amounts. They earned 28k and gave away 26K. DG thanked Ted nikolopoulos for his hard work.
2. Charitable Fund Report: DG who serves on charity committee stated that they have earning 1,800 which is available to use towards donations(80%)
3. Public Relations Report: No one present

N. Old Business

1. Mid Year Conference - 21 brothers in attendance. Main thrust was about what we can do to increase membership. Watertown presented what they are doing to increase membership. They have a questionnaire.

AHEPA Sunday: DG encouraged chapters to be proactive with parish priests to read the announcement. Reserve two pews up front. Sponsor coffee hours and have a table. In Worcester they have the priest read the flyer about AHEPA Sunday and they sponsor the coffee hour. They put out pre addressed envelopes with applications to make it easier for people to apply.

DG stressed how important it is for Chapters to pay their per capita tax and how important it is to the district that chapters pay this amount. Plan was to discuss it further at the convention.

2. Peter Vergados: spoke about the per capita tax and how it came about and what it was to be used for. Came into being in 2014. At last year's convention, it was voted that life members would not need to pay this \$5 fee. There has always been push back from the chapters. According to the by laws of AHEPA, district has the power to impose this tax and chapters do not have a choice to not pay. How do we enforce this rule?

Peter Vergados made a motion to exclude scholarship applicants from being considered for a scholarship if their chapter has not paid their per capita dues.

DG feels that people will try to circumvent this rule.

Motion was made to table original motion further. This motion passed.

Welcome – Woburn Chapter- reinstatement - Chairman welcomed Woburn to the convention

1. Recommendations from Mid-Year workshop- January 18, 2024. Alex Geourntas has offered Boston to be the host of the midyear workshop and was accepted. Place to be determined.

2. 2025 District Bowling Tournament Host: Decision is to host it in the same location in March 2025. Flyer goes out to daughters, maids and sons

3. Recommendations for the District Convention for 2025 - Tri-District conference is planned for May 2025. Next district location for 2026 to be discussed at mid year workshop January 2025

4. Membership - Kosta Speridakos suggested having a district wide event to promote AHEPA.(need more PR, radio shows, barbeque, cigar event, coffee hours at church)

George Lattouf has volunteered to research having a bigger event we could sponsor

If all chapters paid according to paid up members as of 12/31/23, the district would receive \$2,285 towards the budget.

3. Scholarship - Statistics available upon request. Verified that the District gave out 15 scholarships totaling \$26,000 out of \$28,000 available. Letters have been sent out. Discussed possibility of increasing the number of scholarships by shifting dollars, but some of the scholarship funds are mandated by benefactors request. It is something the scholarship committee is going to explore.

4. Charitable Fund - \$1800 available of which 80% can be issued out. Decided that \$500 would go to Holy Trinity Nursing Home; \$500 would go to the Hellenic Nursing Home in Canton; and \$400 to Hellenic Academy in Lowell. They will continue to look for other Hellenic charitable organisations that they can donate to over the course of the coming year.


